

# *TOWN OF HELVETIA MINUTES* *For May 1, 2014*

The regular meeting of the Town Board was held at the Town Hall, and called to order by Chairman, Leonard Oppor at 7:00 PM. Notice of meeting date change was posted as required. All town board members were present. 2 town residents also in attendance.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by Doug Hines, Clerk and approved with a motion by Gary Chich, 2nd by Calvin Preuss. Town bills were approved and paid with a motion by Gary Chich, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Calvin Preuss.

## OLD BUSINESS:

Tree cutting is done on Lutz Road and the County still needs to remove the stumps. Weight limit signs will come down on Monday May 5<sup>th</sup> and board members have been cleaning trash from road sides.

## NEW BUSINESS:

Gary Prill, from the Plan Commission, had nothing to report. Road patching is needed and will start soon. The Board scheduled its 2014 road tour for the 13<sup>th</sup> after the Board of Review. Information has been gathered by board members for construction of a shelter house near the Town Hall. A couple of local contractors have been contacted. Leonard Oppor contacted Ralph Trinkner about painting the Town Hall interior and he will come and take a look at it.

There will be an Iola Ambulance special meeting about the Town of St. Lawrence requesting Iola to cover more area now covered by Manawa Ambulance.

Town roads need to be graded and the County Hwy Dept. will be contacted to do so.

A notice was received from the Waupaca County Treasurer office about having the County collect all property taxes. A motion was made by Gary Chich, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Calvin Preuss to continue with the Town's treasurer collections as in the past. Passed.
