

# *TOWN OF HELVETIA MINUTES* *For August 4, 2014*

The regular meeting of the Town Board was held at the Town Hall, and called to order by Chairman, Leonard Oppor at 7:00 PM. All town board members were present. 2 town residents were also in attendance.

## OLD BUSINESS:

Culvert on Carper Road was plugged by beavers. The Cty Hwy Dept used their equipment to unplug the culvert. The bid for the Town's shelter has been accepted. Crack filling has been completed.

## NEW BUSINESS:

Gary Prill, from the Plan Commission, had nothing to report. Ralph Trinkner will start on the Town Hall painting soon. The Cty Hwy Dept. will work on the Lutz Rd. stumps this fall. The gravel roads in the Town are in good shape and not in need of grading at this time. Walter Bestul is working on the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of mowing of town roads. Work on the shelter will begin August 5<sup>th</sup>. The building permit was filled out and paid for. Road signs are in and the board will put them up in September. The board approved of Leonard Oppor contacting the town lawyer about sending a letter to the owner of the trailer on Cty Rd GG, that the renter's actions are not in the best interest of the Town or the neighbors of the property.
