

TOWN OF HELVETIA MINUTES

For October 2, 2017

The regular meeting of the Town Board was held at the Town Hall, and was called to order by Chairman, Leonard Oppor at 7:00 PM. All town board members were present, except Rosalind Anderson. One town resident was also present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by Doug Hines, Clerk and approved with a motion by Gary Chich, 2nd by Calvin Preuss with one correction on the speed limit sign for Lake Rd to 25mph. Town bills were approved and paid with a motion by Calvin Preuss, 2nd by Gary Chich.

Roger Barthel of Netzler Rd was present to state is disagreement with the Town removing a culvert on his property used for logging purposes. He stated the loggers were not done from the previous winter. The board agreed to let him install a culvert to the Town Road specs, then He would not be charged for the removal of the previous culvert.

A survey map for Marie Murphy was approved with a motion by Calvin Preuss, 2nd by Gary Chich.

OLD BUSINESS:

The water test passed after bleaching the well, the county wants to retest in October. Swamp road will not be blacktopped this year. Because of moneys already budgeted for such this year, the Chair asked about possibly prepaying for some of the blacktopping in advance. The Cty Hwy Dept will cut trees for the remainder of Swamp Road this fall.

NEW BUSINESS:

The plan Commission had nothing to report. Estimates were received for replacing the rear gutters of the Town hall building of \$400 and \$465. A motion the approve the \$400 offer was made by Gary Chich, 2nd by Calvin Preuss. The board will look into replacing the mowing tractor. The Board will attend a County Hwy Dept meeting on October 4th. The Iola Ambulance Service ordered a new ambulance.

Garbage pickup along Hwy GG ongoing.

Gary Chich made a motion to get bids for reassessing the Town when the time comes, 2nd by Calvin Preuss.
