

TOWN OF HELVETIA MINUTES

For October 3, 2016

The regular meeting of the Town Board was held at the Town Hall, and called to order by Chairman, Leonard Oppor at 7:00 PM. All town board members were present. Two town residents also present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by Doug Hines, Clerk and approved with a motion by Gary Chich, 2nd by Calvin Preuss. Town bills were approved and paid with a motion by Calvin Preuss, 2nd by Gary Chich.

Jeff Oppor and Sarah Thiel, representing the Iola-Scandinavia School District, gave a talk and explained the upcoming School District Referendum on November 8th. They also answered any questions by the board.

Jessica Thoe was on the agenda, but did not show.

John Johnson was present to ask about the requested zoning change on his Hwy 161 purchase, and was told a public hearing is set for November 7th at 6:30PM.

OLD BUSINESS:

Grass Cutting is on hold while the mower attachment is being fixed. Lutz Road has been blacktopped and shouldered, with Gary Chich suggesting the shouldering should continue to Hwy GG. Leonard will contact the Hwy Dept.

NEW BUSINESS:

The plan Commission, had nothing to report. A new 3 year service agreement with the Waupaca County Highway Department is set for \$42,100.00 per year. There is a Waupaca County Hwy Shop meeting for the board on Oct. 6th in the Town of Larabee. Leonard Oppor attended the Iola Fire and Ambulance meeting on Sept 29th.

The board finalized a Town Road agreement with the Town of Wyoming and will present it to them for final approval. Garbage along Hwy GG continues.
