

TOWN OF HELVETIA MINUTES
For ANNUAL MEETING APRIL 18, 2017

The Annual meeting of the Town of Helvetia was held at the Town Hall, and called to order by Chairman Leonard Oppor, at 7:00 PM. Nine town residents were present. The minutes of the previous annual meeting were read by Doug Hines, Clerk, and approved with a motion by Gary Chich, 2nd by Calvin Preuss.

OLD TOWN BUSINESS:

Doug Hines, Clerk, presented the 2016 Financial Statement. After review, a motion to approve the 2016 Financial Statement was made by Calvin Preuss, 2nd by Gary Chich.

Lutz Road was blacktopped. Seal coating was put on Stony Ridge Road. Many trees were cut up due to heavy wind damage last year and remaining brush piles will be pushed back once the tractor is up and running for the summer. Also, trees were cut along Moen Road.

NEW TOWN BUSINESS

The South end of Swamp Road has been started with some power and fiber optic lines needing to be moved. Discussion with Town of Wyoming about joint roadways continues. The board is looking for 2 people to join the Plan Commission along with Gary Prill.

The Preuss sand pit on Roland Road was approved by the County.

Ed Moos mentioned about the farming being done on the road right of way on Carper Road, giving no warning for deer crossing the roadway when the corn is high.
